During the January board meeting, a limit of \$250 dollars was set to support the 3rd National BFL show. It will be held at the Black Sheep Gathering in Eugene, Oregon, June 18-20th. Thanks to member volunteers, we have sponsors for all the classes to be held. Please be thinking and working on fleece and fiber arts entries. These can be sent with breeders who are attending the show, or mailed to committee chair Robina Koenig, who has agreed to receive them and to make sure they are returned after the event.

**Most importantly – a reminder that membership dues need to be paid NOW.** To be considered a member in good standing, it is important to get your membership for 2010 paid by March 1st. While dues are still accepted after this date, in order to remain listed on the website, be included in printed membership lists that are passed out at various events, receive your copy of the 2009 Flockbook, and receive your newsletters, it's important to get your dues paid on time. Dues also need to be current in order to vote in BLU elections, and to run for office. All these things can be reinstated once your late dues are paid, but it causes extra work for the secretary, treasurer, and membership chair, and can cause possible errors and corrections to be overlooked.
