The stated purpose of BLU is to promote the breed and the breeders. This is done through the Bluefaced Leicester registry, bflsheep.com web site, advertising and/or breed association listings in appropriate sheep or fiber related magazine, various show catalogs, the BLU display booth, printed literature & handouts.

2008 records show that BLU spent the majority of its income on Associated Sheep Registry's professional services; following that, the 2007 flock book, advertising, promotion, the web site, the BLU library, in addition to miscellaneous office expenses.
